Instructions:

Create a colorful bedtime story about a selected Empire. Your book must address or articulate the following:

- 1. Causes and consequences/effects of an event that took place during the empire or a story about the empire. Look for Political, Economic, and Social causes and consequences -20 points
- 2. Key players in the empire. WHO was involved-20 points
- 3. POV: Write your story FROM EITHER the point of view of the various groups in the event. -30 points
- 4. Contextualization and Synthesis: connect this story to other historical events or across disciplines/subjects (is there a parable to today or another historic time period?). -20 points
- 5. Five Illustrations/images that help tell the story. -10 points
- -Start by using your textbook, Notes, and Documents that can be found online (i.e. Fordham Internet Source Book). We will read bedtime stories in class.

All Stories should begin, "Once upon a time..." However if you have a different idea on how to begin your story you are more than welcome to adjust.
