- 1. HISTORICAL CONTEXT: Connect the document to specific historical events using outside examples. Connect the document across time to earlier and/or later eras or across space to events happening in different places.
- 2. INTENDED AUDIENCE: Identify a person or group the author expects to inform or influence.
- 3. POINT OF VIEW: Who is the author? How did the author's gender/race/economic status impact their written perspective?
- 4. PURPOSE: Why did the author create the source? Think PERSIAN Chart.
- 5. ORGANIZATION in argument (How will you use this source as evidence to support your thesis?)
